REGISTRATION

- · Full payment is required when you make a course booking the exception is our "£750 to start" offer for Level 3 and Level 4 Certificate courses.
- THE FULL BALANCE OF FEES MUST BE PAID AT LEAST 8 WEEKS BEFORE YOUR COURSE ATTENDANCE DATE.
- Failure to pay on time will result in cancellation of your attendance course and no refund will be due.
- · We can take credit/debit card details over the telephone or you may pay by bank transfer.
- Please enter all your details clearly on your booking form including your name as you would like it to appear on your certificate(s).

ONLINE ACCESS TO COURSE

- Access to online training materials (lectures, revision tests, assignments, worksheets, etc) is granted for 12 months from the date you register and pay for your course.
- For courses that require attendance for practical training we do not count the study period leading up to attendance. Access is limited to 12 months from the date of your last attendance/practical training day.
- If you do not complete and pass your course within the 12 month period access will be withdrawn (unless there is significant delay on our part). If you require a further 12 months access to continue your studies payment of £250.00 is required.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- £750.00 to start offer NO REFUND once access has been given to course materials
- · Cancellations made more than 42 days/6 weeks before the course start date full refund LESS £750.00.
- · Cancellations made less than 42 days/6 weeks before the course start date £750.00 deducted/no refund then 50% refund of any further monies paid.
- · Cancellations 14 days or less before the course start date you have booked for attendance/practical training no refund applies.
- If a course is cancelled by Greyfriars due to unforeseen circumstances delegates already booked on the course will be given the choice of an alternative date or a full refund less £750 to start payment.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The entry requirements vary for each course/unit. For higher level qualifications and units we may require previous attainment of other relevant qualifications. It is the student's own responsibility to make themselves aware of the entry requirements prior to completing the booking/registration form. Where prior training/qualification is pre-requisite students will be required to provide evidence such as certificates or transcripts from Qualification Awarding Bodies.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students who do not have English as first language are required to have the following English language qualifications (or equivalent) before registration. Proof will be required.

- · IELTS: 7.5 (with at least 7.0 in each element)
- · TOEFL IBT: 100 with no less than 20 in listening, reading, speaking and writing
