ONLINE ACCESS TO COURSE

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Cancellations made **less than 10 weeks** before the booked attendance date for practical training (day 1) – **NO REFUND**
- If a course is cancelled by Greyfriars, due to unforeseen circumstances, delegates already booked on the course will be given the choice of an alternative date or a full refund less “£1000 to start” payment.
